

- EFE Mission Statement: Preparing Today's Students for Tomorrow's Careers
- Students enrolled in an EFE course have a 97.6% graduation rate.
- EFE students who have completed their programs have a 99.4% post-secondary/employment placement rate.
- 73 of 94 Outstanding 11-12 EFE Seniors received EFE scholarships and cash awards, equivalent to \$60,708.
- Approximately 700 11-12 EFE students received the opportunity for college credit through their EFE programs.
- Over 400 businesses in the community partner with EFE programs and EFE advisory committees.
